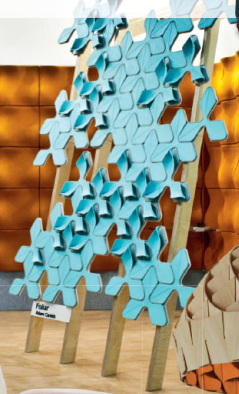
STRAIGHT UP
